

Zarifi earned her MS degree in Urban Design from the American University of Beirut (2016) and has taught at the Beirut Arab University, lectured at the American University of Beirut and participated in various design workshops and researches in Lebanon and Europe. In addition to her experience in the fields of architecture and design, she is a self-taught Illustrator and has worked on a couple of award winning children books.

Zarifi is passionate about art and design and spends most of her free time taking photos, creating, drawing and doodling. She illustrates to smile and get smiles from those looking at her work.



“A doodle a day keeps the psychologist away” has been my favorite motto for a long time.

A few years ago, I started doodling as a way of expressing my frustrations, worries, and even my anxieties. I doodled almost every day, everywhere and anywhere; and, thanks to this practice, I learned to create something funny out of the events that are pulling me down.

Today, I see the world in colors. I do not only try to find the bright side of things, but I invent it if I cannot find it and I encourage others to do the same. I doodle and draw as often as I can. Any surface on

which I can capture my emotions and thoughts is a valid canvas and my favorite tools are those at hand. Most of the time - for practical reasons - these end up being my A5 sketchbook, ink liner pens and mobile phone. But I am always eager to learn, experiment and play with different techniques.


The map was included in the next TDAT book, a compilation of the 100 best maps submitted to the Mapping Special Places contest. The book will be available in early 2020.


BEIRUT IS...HETEROTOPIA

"Beirut Is" collective exhibition.

The city is conceptualized as a heterotopic space in the Foucauldian understanding of the term: a space that functions in non-hegemonic conditions.

It is perceived as an alternative site – paradoxically a capital city, not a site at the peripheries like

the prisons, mental institutions and schools Foucault speaks about - where people's past and memories of the city as a site of everyday life overlap with its present appropriation by the real estate sector and with its controlled mobility and monumentality.




